You may have received a phone call last month concerning the change in garbage pickup due to the icy weather. This was the first time the Village activated the dialing system that we have to notify residents of emergencies and other events that are time sensitive.



If you did not get called, you can still sign up to receive calls, text messages, and/or emails from the Village. To do so, logon to spencerwi.org and click the CodeRED Button near the top of the page. This will take you to a signup page by the company that the Village is working with. All information you enter is confidential and the Village will never share your phone number.

Unwanted Prescription Drug Collection

The Village of Spencer was awarded two grants from the Wisconsin Dept. of Agriculture Trade and Consumer Protection and from the Marathon County Drug Free Communities Program to start an unwanted drug collection program. With this money, the Village of Spencer has placed an unwanted prescription drug collection box inside the lobby of the police station. Ordinance 480-69 Outside Storage of Refuse; Junk

No manure, salvage material, inoperable vehicles, rubbish, or miscellaneous refuse may be stored within any residential district when the same may be construed as a menace to the public health or safety or may be held to have a depressing influence upon property values in the area. Junk shall be placed in properly zoned junkyards only. See the full ordinance at spencerwi.org

Project Updates

The Village is completing two major road construction projects this year and several smaller maintenance programs.

The first major project involves paving both Hickory and Truman Streets. This project includes adding curb and gutter and rerouting a major sewer line. Along with this project, the Village is installing a drainage ditch running from East Willow to East Hickory that will lead to a retaining pond located on Hickory Street.

The second project is paving North LaSalle from State Highway 13 North to Northcentral Technical College. This project includes replacing a shallow waterline that has a tendency to freeze up during the winter.

Major road reconstruction projects are expensive, so the Village is once again planning on conducting several road maintenance projects that will extend the life of our local roads. The Village is looking at placing a thin overlay on South Jefferson, paving South Washington, conducting routine crack sealing, and patching water main break street damage.

Over the last several years Spencer has been very aggressive in restoring and reconstructing roads. The Village Board feels, that since interest rates have been historical low, now has been the best time in years to tackle these projects.

Well #7 Update

The Village conducted three test bores to identify a new well. One came back with good preliminary results. The Village chose to go to the second phase of testing which included installing a 6ö test well. This test well pumped at approximately 60 gallons per minute, which was similar to what Well #6 pumped when it was being tested. The Village is having water samples tested to determine water quality. Our hope is that the tests come back showing that we have located a strong source of safe drinking water, and the Village will be able to move ahead with placing a permanent well at this site.

271-5 Regulation of Length of Lawn and Grasses You can find this ordinance at spencerwi.org or you can request a copy from the Village Office. You are required to keep grass in residential areas no longer than 8 inches in length for the health and safety of the community. This ordinance will be enforced.

You asked, we are delivering! Effective with your WSGR bill that will be sent on March 26th and due April 15th, you will be able to have an automatic payment from your savings or checking with no cost to you. On the reverse side of this insert, you will find an authorization form that explains the date payments will be made, penalties for NSF or for failing to inform us of account changes, and the information required to use this service.

Payment Service Network will remain active for those of you who choose to use a credit card payment or prefer this payment service.

Authorization forms must be in the Village Office NO LATER THAN THE 11TH of the month the draw will happen. Direct payments, for the full amount due, will be made on the 15th of each month unless the 15th falls on a weekend or Holiday observed by the Federal Reserve Bank. The payment will then happen on the next business day after the 15th (example: April 15th is on a Sunday so the payment will be drawn on the 16th).

If you have a bank or account change, or wish to cancel the payment, you must notify the Village Office in writing by completing a change/cancellation form with your signature no later than the 11th of the month in which the change is to take place. We reserve the right to restrict excessive ins and outs of the program. Please note that the bank account holder's signature, if different from the WSGR account holder, is required.

ALSO.... If you would like your bill sent via e-mail vs. US Postal Service, please let us know. We will begin e-mailing bills sent out on April 25th. Authorization for e-mailed bills is included on the Direct Payment form. If you would like to have your bill sent by e-mail but do not wish to have automatic payments, please stop in or contact us for a form. PLEASE NOTE: if you do not receive your bill either by mail or e-mail, don't hesitate to contact the Village Office. They are still due and payable.

ALL DIRECT PAYMENTS WILL BE DRAWN ON THE 15TH OF EACH MONTH UNLESS IT FALLS ON A WEEKEND OR HOLIDAY OBSERVED BY THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANK. THE DRAW WILL THEN HAPPEN ON THE NEXT BUSINESS DAY AFTER THE 15TH.
